A motorcycle may be entered by the same rider in multiple classes.

*Class details have changed for 2012. The Supermini and Schoolboy Classes are now separated into 4 different age groups.

BEGINNER CLASS: Riders with 6 months or less motocross experience. Beginner class can not jump the "Main Double". Riders attempting to ride the beginner class who have raced more than 6 months will be automatically advanced to the next skill level.

RULES

The Ontario Arenacross Championship will use the 2011 AMA Racing Rulebook.

The following supplemental rules apply.

Warning Flags

Stationary Yellow Flag:

Exercise Caution

Waving Yellow Flag: indicates serious hazard on or near the track

Passing is allowed

Proceed with extreme caution

RACE FINISHES:

Races are officially ended for all contestants at the completion of the lap in which the checkered flag is displayed to the winner

Riders will be credited with all laps they complete during a race unless a penalty has been assessed.

Riders who do not complete the checkered flag lap will be scored in order of finish and laps completed.

ELIGIBILITY:

Racing is open to all ages, skill levels and abilities

REGISTRATION:

At registration riders will be able to see a list of general rules, practice schedule, and practice ticket(s). It is the rider's responsibility to read and understand the general rules and schedule. Violations will be handled at the discretion of the referee. NO REFUNDS ONCE PRACTICE BEGINS!

GUARDIANSHIP: If you are a parent of an underage rider that is not planning to attend with the minor you must bring a signed release statement, authorizing your underage rider with permission to race.

AGE LIMITS:

A rider's age as of January 1st 2012 will determine his/her age for the series.

QUALIFYING POSITIONS:

The number of qualifying positions out of the heats and semis that make it to the main event is determined by the number of entries in your particular class.

MINICYCLE:

All minicycle class machines must be run in the class for which they were originally manufactured, (excluding supermini and schoolboy).

PRACTICE:

At registration you will be given a list of general rules, practice schedule, and practice tickets. It is your responsibility to read and understand the general rules and schedule. Amateurs; One practice per class. Violators will be handled at discretion of the referee. NO REFUNDS ONCE PRACTICE BEGINS!

SPECTATOR TICKETS:

Tickets will allow you into the facility at the following times Saturday 7:00am - \$5 Spectator Fee

PLEASE NOTE:

- *No gas cans or alcohol allowed in the building
- *No riding bikes, scooters, etc. outdoors
- *No pets allowed in the building

ONTARIO ARENACROSS MEMBERSHIP:

Ontario Arenacross membership is required to compete in Ontario Arenacross Series and proof of membership must be presented at registration. You can purchase onsite at event registration for \$40/season.

REGISTRATION

PRE-REGISTRATION: You may pre-register at WCK HONDA the Wednesday to Friday before each event.

ENTRY FEES: (Ontario Arenacross membership required) *Total entry fees include rider pit pass for that day of racing.
